

Covid-19 Related Pupil Absence
A Quick Reference Guide for Parents

What to do if...	Action Needed	Return to school when...
<p>My child has Covid-19 symptoms – one of the following:</p> <p>High temperature – this means your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to measure the temperature)</p> <p>A new continuous cough – this means coughing for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours</p> <p>A loss or change to their sense of smell – this means your child has noticed they cannot smell or taste anything, or things taste or smell differently to normal</p>	<p><u>DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL</u></p> <p>Contact the school to inform us</p> <p>Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days</p> <p>Book a test</p> <p>INFORM THE SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY WITH THE RESULT OF THE TEST</p>	<p>The test result comes back negative</p>
<p>My child tests positive for Covid-19</p>	<p><u>DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL</u></p> <p>Agree a date of return with Mr Pearson – Headteacher</p> <p>Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days</p> <p>Your child's bubble will isolate</p> <p>Remote learning will commence</p>	<p>Your child feels better</p> <p>Your child has isolated with the household for 14 days</p>
<p>My child tests negative</p>	<p>CONTACT THE SCHOOL</p> <p>Arrange a return to school start time with Mr Pearson – Headteacher (this will likely be the following day)</p>	<p>The test comes back negative</p>
<p>My child is ill with symptoms not linked to Covid-19</p>	<p>Follow the school's attendance policy – found via the school's website</p>	<p>After 48 hours after the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea if this is the cause of absence</p>
<p>Someone in y household has Covid-19 symptoms</p>	<p><u>DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL</u></p> <p>Contact the school to inform us</p> <p>Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days</p>	<p>The tests come back negative</p>

	<p>Book tests for the whole household</p> <p>INFORM THE SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY WITH THE RESULT OF THE TEST</p>	
Someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19	<p><u>DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL</u></p> <p>Contact the school to inform us</p> <p>Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days</p> <p>Agree a date of return with Mr Pearson – Headteacher (a minimum of 14 days)</p>	Your household has completed 14 days of isolation
NHS 'Test and Trace' has identified someone in your household as being in contact with someone with a confirmed case of Covid-19	<p><u>DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL</u></p> <p>Contact the school to inform us</p> <p>Self-isolate the whole household for 14 days</p> <p>Agree a date of return with Mr Pearson – Headteacher (a minimum of 14 days)</p>	Your household has completed 14 days of isolation
My child's bubble is closed due to a Covid-19 outbreak in school	<p><u>DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL</u></p> <p>Remote learning will commence</p> <p>Your child will need to self-isolate for 14 days</p> <p>Siblings may still attend school in differing bubbles unless they are showing symptoms (Lutton St Nicholas only)</p>	The school will inform you via the 'Our School App' when the bubble is to return to school
Our household is self-isolating after travelling to countries on the quarantine list: https://www.gov.uk/guidance/coronavirus-covid-19-travel-corridors	<p>Do not take unauthorised leave during term time</p> <p>Consider quarantine requirements and FCO</p>	Your household has completed 14 days of isolation
