## But who is St George?

It's also believed that he was a Roman officer of Greek descent who died as a martyr for Christianity. Following the Battle of Agincourt, St. George's Day became one of the most important feast days in the English calendar.

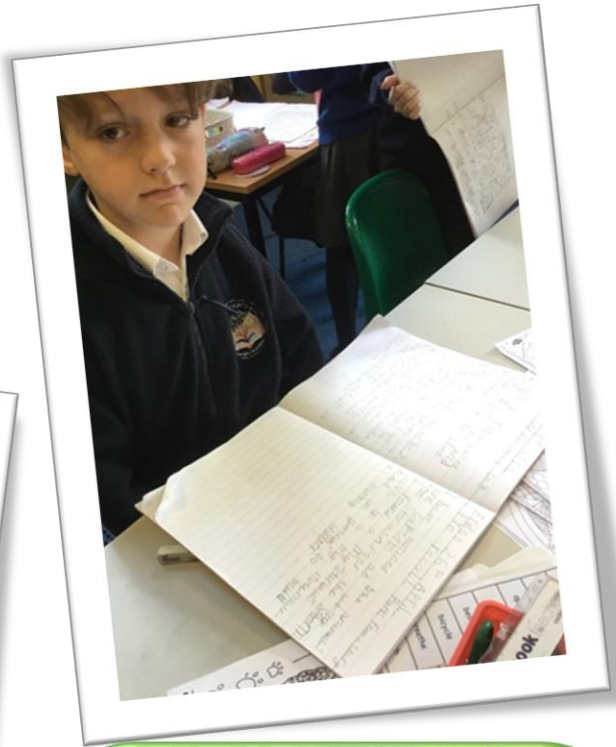
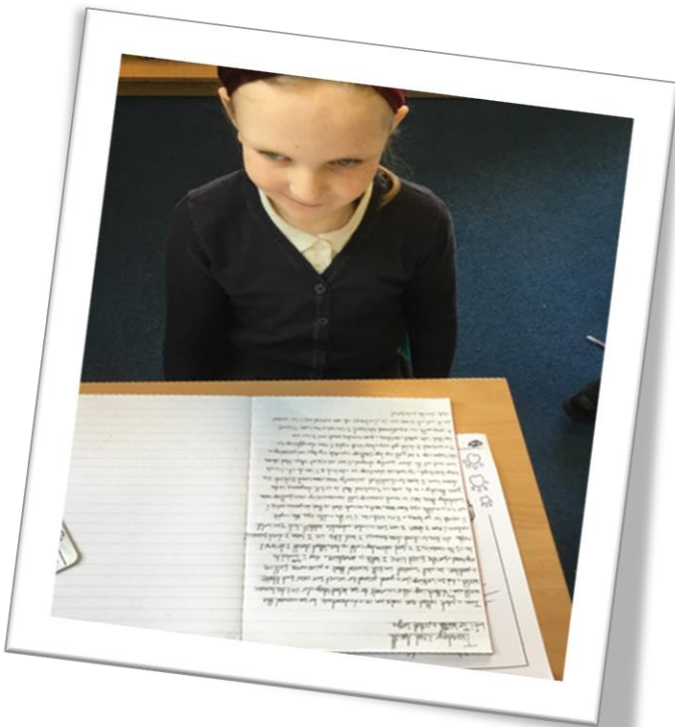


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## This week in class
